In partnership with Registered Providers, local authorities and government agencies, Galliford Try has extensive experience of masterminding award-winning regeneration schemes – whether these originate from cleared brownfield sites or involve injecting new life into occupied neighbourhoods.

We excel in putting together technically challenging solutions. Our skill in bringing sites back into productive use begins at the land acquisition stage. Then, where appropriate, our remediation team – with extensive experience in the sector – provides comprehensive services to deal with all aspects of contamination.

Our expertise in renewing and preparing redundant land for new build is matched by our flair for renewing the physical environment of neighbourhoods with a history of social and structural problems. In doing so, we focus first and foremost on the wellbeing of residents – both long term, as we create a more cohesive, sustainable community, and in the short term while we are working on site.

In order to minimise inconvenience during refurbishment, we have been developing our resident liaison officer (RLO) role for 18 years. Our directly employed RLOs work sensitively to create effective relationships between onsite teams and residents.
